OPERATIONS

RELIEF WORK – FOOD DONATION DRIVE

COVID -19 relief work continued in May 2020 also. May 2020 relief work proved to be very crucial in many terms. It was not only helpful to support the needy but also in various other NGOs, GHMC and Police department joining hands with us in enabling us to keep the relief work going. Our friends, sponsors and well-wishers always trust us and support us in all our endeavors but this was probably the first time that the Government departments worked together with us.

Distribution of different types of food kits to the needy continued for the whole month.

- Grocery kits – to the families of students and staff of Akshaya Vidya Learning Centres (102).
- Cooked food packets – to the people in Singareni and Borabanda areas.
- Snacks kits – to the students of AVLCS.
- Bread kits – to the migrants travelling by “Shramik” trains.

GROCERY KITS

1500 grocery kits were prepared by Ekalavya Foundation – Akshaya Vidya with the financial support given by our well-wishers and sponsors. Each kit contained

Distribution of Bread Packets to Migrants Returning Home



BREAD KITS

The hard working migrant workers who had come to our city for earning some decent money were the worst hit in these COVID times. With no work and wages, daily survival became a big problem. Returning to their homes to their loved ones became an even bigger problem due to the absence of transport services. Shramik trains finally came to their rescue to take them home. Travelling from far off places to reach the railway stations, finding food also was a big challenge. So on the request of GHMC and Police department, we took up the distribution of bread kits to the people travelling by Shramik trains. The distribution was conducted from 16.05.2020 to 30.05.2020. The material that was distributed included

- ✓ Milk bread - 400gms - (34650 packets)
- ✓ Cream biscuits - 100gms (5000 packets)
- ✓ Digestive biscuits - 100 gms (1500 packets)
- ✓ Good Day biscuit packets - 100gms (30000 packets)
- ✓ Peanut chikki packets -
- ✓ Pickle - 50 gms (39650 packets)
- ✓ Poha - 200gms with Sugar - 50gms (1500 packets) and
- ✓ Sweet lime (20 tonnes)

ACADEMICS

BODHANA - 2020

The annual summer skill development training program - BODHANA- 2020, for the coordinators and tutors of Akshaya Vidya was held this year also, but virtually from 27.04.2020 to 11.05.2020.

REOPENING OF AVLC:

AVLCs reopened from 05.05.20 onwards and 58 centres are functioning on 30.05.20 with an average attendance of 8 – 10 students per AVLC. Compulsory wearing of masks and maintaining proper social distance has been made mandatory norm. The students are being made aware of the precautionary methods to protect themselves and coexist with COIVD-19 apart from being engaged in activities like rhymes, storytelling, art and craft, essay writing, learning multiplication tables etc.
